- ➤ <u>Dress Code</u> As the weather is turning cooler, just a reminder that only plain solid colored sweaters or sweatshirts that match the uniform shirt colors of red, white or navy blue are acceptable to be worn in the classroom. Yellow has also been approved as an acceptable sweatshirt color. The complete dress code is attached for your reference.
- ➤ No After School Care Nov. 20th There will be NO After School Care on Friday, Nov. 20th after our Noon Dismissal. Please be on time to pick up your child.
- ➤ <u>Updated Health Guidelines</u> The Washington State Department of Health has updated their guidelines by extending the amount of time for a student to stay at home after experiencing symptoms consistent with COVID-19. The new guideline is that if you have not been tested for COVID-19 you must stay home for at least 10 days from the onset of symptoms and with the last 24 hours fever free and improved symptoms.
