- ➤ <u>Updated Health Guidelines</u> The Washington State Department of Health has updated their guidelines by extending the amount of time for a student to stay at home after experiencing symptoms consistent with COVID-19. The new guideline is that if you have not been tested for

COVID-19 you must stay home for at least 10 days from the onset of symptoms and with the last 24 hours fever free and improved symptoms. Mr. Jacaban sent a letter out last week explaining these guidelines. Here is the DOH's guidance for schools.
