- ➤ <u>School Pictures</u> Your student's pictures were taken on this week. Vladimir Bokov, PSAA Technology Director was our photographer. He has taken several different shots of your child. The website is password protected, you will need to click on the album and enter password: **pictures2020**. You will then select the picture you would like printed. - ➤ <u>Morning Drop-Off</u> —Please remain in your vehicle for one of our screening team to come to you for your daily morning temperature & wellness check.

- ➤ <u>Emergency Kits</u> Friday, September 25th is the final day to provide your student with an Emergency Kit. Any student who doesn't have one after that deadline will have one provided and their account will be charged.
- ➤ <u>Hot Lunch</u> Our hot lunch program is currently put on hold due to increased COVID-19 safety measures on campus. Students will need to bring a lunch each day to school. Ordering food to be delivered to campus is also suspended due to increased safety measures at this time.
- ➤ <u>Playground Closed before & after school</u> Our playground is closed to all before school & after school to everyone except those signed-in to our After School Care program. Thank you for your understanding.
- ➤ <u>Volunteers</u> If you plan to volunteer on campus <u>when safety precautions allow</u>, you must have a current background screening on file. Volunteer options includes but is not limited to helping in the classroom, driving on field trips, & helping with hot lunch. Screenings are good for 3 years. If you would like to become a volunteer, the instructions are attached, or if you need to check the status of your screening please contact the school office.
- ➤ Parking Spaces All numbered spaces on campus are assigned and reserved for teachers and students between 7 am and 4 pm. Please use the "Visitor" spaces by the office when you are on campus during the day. Or you can use the un-numbered spaces facing the field during drop-off and pick-up.

➤ <u>Hot Lunch Helpers</u> – If you are able to help with our hot lunch program <u>when it is able to restart</u>, you must have a current Food Handlers License. If you need to renew or apply for a license, please visit your County's Health Services website to complete the online requirements.
